Cadette Requirements

Show off your leadership skills and earn your Leader-in-Action (LiA) award by by assisting your Brownie sisters with a National Leadership Journey!

To earn your LiA award:

- Find a group of Girl Scout Brownies who are about to begin—or have recently started—a National Leadership Journey.
 - If you don't know any Brownie troops, ask an adult troop or a service unit volunteer for assistance.
- 2. Connect with the Brownies' troop leaders to discover how you can assist with the Journey.
 - Learn about the Brownies' interests and find out if the leaders are facing any Journeyrelated challenges.
 - o If applicable, read the Journey requirements and adult guide.
- 3. Collaborate with the troop leaders to schedule dates and times.
- 4. Plan your activities! Make sure each is fun, engaging, and appropriate for the girls' program level.
 - o If you're unsure about any aspect of your plan, don't hesitate to check in with leaders of the Brownie troop and/or your own troop.
- 5. After completing your activities, ask their troop leaders for feedback.
 - o What worked well? What might you do differently next time?
- 6. Now that you've finished the project part of your LiA, think about and answer these questions:
 - o What did you **Discover** about yourself as you guided Brownies?
 - o In what ways did you **Connect** with Brownies? Why is it important to engage with younger girls?
 - o How did you encourage Brownies to **Take Action?**
