Special activities include a Friday and Saturday night activity. In addition girls will make many new friends and have a lot of fun at camp.

Come join us for a weekend of sleuthing where you and your friends become detectives. Explore fingerprints, paper making, grow your own sugar crystal, spend some time with a real detective, and see if you can solve the mystery at Camp Innisfree. During your time with us, you will complete many challenges to find out who the thief is and what happened to the magical goblet. Brownies will earn their Science Wonders Try-It and Juniors will earn their Science Sleuth badge.

GSSEM CAMPS

Camp Hawthorn Hollow - in Columbus (St. Clair County), features a fun free-choice program that allows girls to create a schedule that reflects their interests and abilities. There are also great performing arts and leadership training offerings. Other features include outdoor pool, equestrian center, and climbing wall/high ropes course.

Camp Innisfree - in Howell (Livingston County) has a year-round equestrian center with multiple riding rings and trail ride options. In addition to horseback riding instruction for beginner through advanced riders, there is a farm barn with various small animals. Sports, leadership, science, bikes, ropes course, and lakefront fun are all part of the Innisfree adventure.

Playfair Program Center - in Lexington (Sanilac County), serves K – 12th grade girls. The experience is one for troops to attend. The 18 acre camp on Lake Huron offers many of the program highlights that make traditional summer camp popular, such as campfires, arts and crafts, swimming and boating. We offer the traditional summer camp programs in a troop camp environment.

The Timbers - in Traverse City (Grand Traverse County), offers exciting trip programs to girls in middle school and older. Girls explore arts, canoeing, sailing, backpacking, and cycling. Progression is the key to this program, meaning that girls build on skills each summer they return, taking longer and more challenging trips. Girls entering grade 6: remember that you can choose from one or two week programs at The Timbers. In addition to trip programs, there are weeklong art, adventure, and swimming programs.
