### **Girl Scouts of Southeastern Michigan Troop 50001 – Port Huron State of Purpose**

Girl Scouts of Southeastern Michigan has established a council-wide troop to apply and serve on Mackinac Island at the Mackinac Island State Park Scout Service Camp. Troop 001 is known as the Mackinac Island Honor Guard. Troop 001 is accountable to the Mackinac Historic State Parks Commission while serving on the island. The troop is responsible to:

1. Raise and lower all flags at designated State owned properties on the island.
2. Act as guides for tourists in Fort Mackinac historic buildings.
3. Complete service projects that aid the Mackinac Historic State Parks Commission
4. Care for and maintain the Service Camp Barracks where they live on the island.
5. Assist state employees and staff as requested.

For this troop of Girls ages 12-18 our purpose is to provide quality Girl Scout Program which will build girl of courage, confidence and character, who make the world a better place.

### **Goals**

1. Troop 50001 will train its members to successfully perform the duties requested by the Mackinac State Historic Parks Commission as a Mackinac Island Honor Guard Troop.
2. Troop 50001 will strive to incorporate the Girl Scout Promise and Law into all activities. Troop 001 will at all times be governed by the policies and standards of GSUSA and Girl Scouts of Southeastern Michigan Council.
3. Troop 50001 will encourage personal growth, leadership development and social responsibility in all members, both girl and adult.
4. Troop 50001 will work to remove barriers that may prevent a willing applicant from participating in the Mackinac Island Honor Guard experience.

**ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION:**

**STEP ONE:** Carefully read through the entire application. **Please note the mandatory training dates** and make sure you **do not have conflicts**. Decide if you are willing to make the commitment, fill out the form and mail it to the address given. **Do not drop / or mail** the application form to any of the Girl Scout Service Centers.

**STEP TWO:** Ask someone to fill out the adult recommendation form. Give them the form and a **stamped, address envelope**. They should **mail the reference directly** to the address given.

**STEP THREE:** You **must attend** Selection Day. This day is set aside to learn more about you. Come **prepared** to give a **two-minute presentation** on any aspect of **Mackinac Island**. You will need to **bring a sack lunch and beverage** to Selection Day. Dress is casual, a uniform is not necessary.

**STEP FOUR:** You will be notified by mail if you are selected about a week after selection day. You will also be notified if you are chosen as an alternate or if you were not selected.

**STEP FIVE:** If you are selected, you will be expected to attend all scheduled training sessions. This training includes flag etiquette, marching skills, Mackinac Island history and guide duty responsibilities.

**IMPORTANT:** *Girls who miss a training may be asked to give up their spot to another more committed girl.*

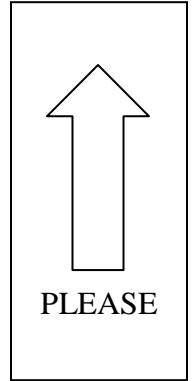

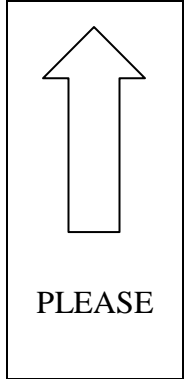

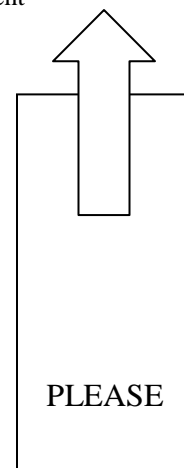
