Michigan Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement and Potential has generously granted Girl Scouts of Southeastern Michigan funds to be offered as free camperships to any financially eligible Girl Scout in the council.

When is the camp?

You can choose from any open session on the camp website. If the session is filled, it will say "Sold Out" at the beginning of the description.

How long is the camp?

Camps range from 3-day mini-camp to 5-day full camp.

What ages can attend camp?

Girls who are entering grades 2–12 in Fall 2026

What does the campership cover?

The campership covers the advertised camp fee which includes all activities and meals. Campers will be responsible for all camping necessities listed on the website (bedding, clothing, etc.). See our Summer Camp Guide at www.gssem.org/campguide for details.

Is transportation to the camp provided?
