General Information

Top Seller rewards are rewards that scouts earn at the 750+ box level and above. Girl Scouts can earn special events/trips at the following Top Seller reward levels this season: 750+, 1,250+, 1,600+, 2,026+, and 3,000+. These events/trips are hosted on specific dates throughout the summer; there are no make-up dates. If a Girl Scout is not able to attend the event or trip on the scheduled dates, she should choose the alternative reward option at that level. Please reference the 2026 Cookie Order Card Order Card for more information on alternative reward options. Girl Scouts are not able to attend the Top Seller events/trips if their troop opts out of rewards. Caregivers of Girl Scouts who earn Top Seller rewards are responsible for communicating their Girl Scout's reward selections to their troop leader.

750+ Level - Movie Day Cookie Celebrations

Girl Scouts who sell 750 boxes of cookies or more may choose <u>ONE</u> Cookie Celebration event <u>OR</u> a JBL Speaker. For the 2026 season, we will host Movie Day Cookie Celebrations at various Emagine theater locations:

Novi – June 12, 2026 Macomb – June 13, 2026 Woodhaven – June 19, 2026 Royal Oak – June 20, 2026



Movie Day Cookie Celebrations will include admission to a screening of a movie (movie choice and showtime to be determined) in a theater specially reserved for top sellers and their caregivers. Concessions will be provided for the scout and one adult chaperone.

1,250+ Level

Girl Scouts who sell 1,250 boxes of cookies or more may choose <u>ONE</u> Day at the Theme Park at Cedar Point <u>OR</u> Michigan's Adventure <u>OR</u> King's Island. The Day at the Park celebrations are as follows:

King's Island | Mason, OH – July 11, 2026 Michigan's Adventure | Muskegon - July 14, 2026 Cedar Point | Sandusky, OH – July 23, 2026

All Day at the Theme Park celebrations will include admission for the Girl Scout and one adult chaperone, 2 meal vouchers, and 1 parking pass. There are no scheduled times for the Day at the Theme Park celebrations; guests may arrive at their leisure on the scheduled date.

1,600+ Level

Girl Scouts who sell 1,600 boxes of cookies or more may choose between a jewelry-making experience at Rebel Nell <u>OR</u> a GSSEM Summer Camp experience.

Rebel Nell Experience - July 25, 2026

The Rebel Nell experience will include a tour of the Rebel Nell Headquarters (located in Eastern Market) for the Girl Scout and one adult chaperone, as well as the opportunity for the Girl Scout to design her own bracelet (bracelet design will be for the scout only). This event will require scheduled time slots, which will be coordinated directly with those who earn/choose this reward as we get closer to the event date.

GSSEM Summer Camp - TBD

The 2026 Summer Camp dates and information will be available in early 2026. Once available, the camp information will be posted on the GSSEM website and sent out via eBudde. Girls earning the camp reward will be contacted in mid-April 2026 to select their camp.

Note: Girls that want to attend a specific week of summer camp may consider registering for that week when registration opens by paying the required deposit. This will ensure the camp does not fill up before the summer camp rewards are processed. Once the summer camp rewards are processed, your deposit will be refunded.

2,026+ Level

Girl Scouts who sell 2,026 boxes of cookies or more may choose between the Cookie Stars Party at CJ Barrymore's **OR** a Fitbit Activity Tracker.

CJ Barrymore's Cookie Star Party - June 27, 2026

The CJ Barrymore's Cookie Stars Party will be a private event for the Girl Scout and one adult chaperone, and will include a four-hour unlimited wristband; lunch will also be provided.

3,000+ Level

Girl Scouts who sell 3,000 boxes of cookies or more may choose between a trip to Mackinac Island (all levels, girl and one adult) <u>OR</u> the Playground Active System <u>OR</u> a Meta Quest VR Headset. The trip dates are as follows:

<u>August 2-4, 2026:</u> Mackinac Island – this trip will accommodate the scout (any level) and ONE adult chaperone. GSSEM Staff will be present to facilitate activities. This trip will include hotel accommodations for 2 nights, meals, and admission to various attractions in the area for the scout and ONE adult chaperone. Transportation to and from Mackinac City will not be provided.

<u>There are no make-up dates or exceptions allowed for this trip.</u> If a Girl Scout is not able to attend, she should select one of the alternative reward options for the 3,000+ level.
