Overview of Community Girl Scout Troops

Community Girl Scout troops provide girls who do not currently have access to a local Girl Scout troop, or for whom a traditional Girl Scout troop is not a good fit, with the opportunity to experience all that Girl Scouting has to offer. This welcoming program ensures every girl has a place to belong while building courage, confidence, and character. Through engaging, hands-on activities, girls will explore entrepreneurship, first aid, career exploration, art, and culinary arts while developing leadership skills, making new friends, and discovering their unique strengths.

Volunteer Needs

Community volunteers are essential to making this program possible. By sharing their time, talents, and life experiences, volunteers help create meaningful opportunities for girls who might not otherwise have access to Girl Scouts. Whether leading an activity, mentoring girls, or lending a helping hand, volunteers inspire the next generation, strengthen their community, and ensure every girl has the chance to learn, grow, and succeed.

Volunteer Requirements

- Open to adults age 18+
- Register as an adult member of Girl Scouts of the USA for an annual fee of \$30
- Complete a volunteer background check screening
- Complete a 1-hour online training: Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention
- Complete a 30-minute virtual training with the Project Manager at a date and time that works for you

Volunteer Commitment

Each session runs for 3 hours. Volunteers are asked to pick a minimum of 2 sessions. Volunteers may choose as many sessions as their schedule allows. Volunteers are asked to commit to volunteering at least 2 weeks prior to the first session you choose, to allow time for background check screening and training.
