Girl Scouts Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Course



Cookie Booth Tips

Cookie booths help Girl Scouts flex their customer service, money management, inventory management, and teamwork skills. Keep these tips in mind to make sure your troop's cookie booths are productive and safe:

- Keep doorways clear and ensure pedestrians, bikes, and cars can safely pass by.
- Make sure there is adequate space for a table to display cookies and for Girl Scouts to stand around it.
- · Have a first aid kit available at the booth.
- Use a money pouch to hold cash for the booth.



Camp & Outdoor Experience

These trainings explore outdoor skills. Some courses are required to attend Girl Scouts of Southeastern Michigan camps.

Troop Camp



Outdoor 1: Preparing Your Troop For Camp

Get to know Girl Scouts of Southeastern Michigan's camps, facility policies and procedures, and outdoor progression in Girl Scouting on these information sessions.

This training is required for at least one volunteer of any troop planning to go troop camping at a GSSEM camp.

In this training, we will discuss how to work with your Girl Scouts to plan an amazing cabin camping trip.

This course is required for all troops planning a troop camping trip at Camp Hawthorn Hollow or Camp Playfair.

This portion is focused on preparing your troop to camp beyond the cabin. This course is required for all troops planning a tent camping trip or cooking over a campfire at Camp Hawthorn Hollow or Camp Playfair.

This training for Girl Scouts discusses the importance of watersheds and how you can keep them healthy.





Youth Mental Health First Aid is an early intervention public education program. It teaches adults how to recognize the signs and symptoms that suggest a potential mental health challenge, how to listen nonjudgmentally and give positive reassurance, and how to refer a person to appropriate professional support and services.
